



AGREEMENT CONCERNING TREATMENT WITH SPERM FROM A RHESUS POSITIVE DONOR

hereinafter 'the LUFC', on the one hand,

hereinafter 'the prospective parents', on the other hand,

the following has been agreed:

- The prospective parents are aware of the potential consequences and risks if the patient has a Rhesus negative blood type the sperm donor's blood group is Rhesus positive:
 - ◆ If the sperm donor has a Rhesus positive blood type, he may pass this on to the child, resulting in a Rhesus positive blood type in the child. During pregnancy there is a small risk that the baby's blood will enter the mother's circulation. During birth, however, the risk is quite considerable.
 - ◆ In the following situations an injection of anti-D immune globulin (= Rhogam®) will be recommended to Rhesus negative women: a curettage procedure following a miscarriage or spontaneous miscarriage after 10 weeks of pregnancy; an ectopic pregnancy; chorionic villus sampling or amniocentesis; and situations involving heavy external pressure on the uterus, i.e. during version of a baby in breech position, after serious trauma to the abdomen, such as a car crash, fall on the abdomen or a kick in the abdomen.
 - ◆ After delivery an injection of anti-D immune globulin (= Rhogam®) is always necessary IF the child is Rhesus positive.
 - ◆ Despite these measures there is still a small risk that the baby's blood may enter the mother's circulation "unnoticed" and consequently no injection has been being administered. If this happens the mother may produce antibodies that may cause to problems during a subsequent pregnancy.
- The prospective parents were advised accordingly by the physician in charge of the treatment and they do not object.
- The prospective parents declare that, as part of an intrauterine insemination or in-vitro fertilisation procedure, they consent to a sperm donor with a Rhesus positive blood group.
